LETTER FROM THE DIRECTOR



Dear Class of COMM 2023,

Welcome to Queen's University, situated on traditional Anishinaabe and Haudenosaunee Territory.

You are now a part of The Stephen J.R. Smith School of Business, Commerce Class of 2023, the 100th class to enter the Commerce Program. You are about to become a part of a tradition of excellent business students and Commerce graduates working in varied fields around the world. Your journey is now beginning; the next four years promise to be challenging, enriching, and rewarding.

The Smith Commerce experience begins with Orientation Week - organized and hosted by our second and third year students. The students on the Commerce Executive on Orientation (the CEO) have worked hard to create a memorable week for you: a week where you will be introduced to Queen's, the Smith School of Business, faculty and staff and, perhaps most importantly, your new peers. I commend the members of the CEO for their enthusiasm, hard work, and dedication to the School.

Most students are excited about Orientation Week, however, many students experience some anxiety about what events will transpire and what is expected of them. Queen's University whole-heartedly supports the following goals of Orientation Week:

- To make all new students feel welcome;
- To facilitate a smooth transition to university;
- To build a strong and inclusive community of students;
- To make new students comfortable in their academic, social, and environmental contexts;
- To provide a solid foundation for a successful university experience.

The events during Orientation Week are approved and monitored by the Senate Orientation Activities Review Board. The Bosses (Orientation Week Leaders) are carefully selected and trained for their roles as leaders of new students. To ensure the safety of students and the enjoyment of the week, all students – Orientation Week Leaders as well as first year students – are held to the standard of behaviour set out in the Queen's University Student Code of Conduct, including the statement addressing hazing. As stated in the Code of Conduct, "hazing activities include, but are not limited to, pranks, jokes, public ridicule, and any activity that does not respect an individual's rights, integrity, dignity, safety or well-being. Hazing includes conduct...that is used as a means of coercing, compelling, forcing, or otherwise socially pressuring, a person to gain or maintain membership in, the acceptance of, or association with any group or organization."

Students shall not organize or participate in hazing activities, on or off-campus." Any activity that is part of Orientation Week should not humiliate, degrade, or risk emotional and/or physical harm, regardless of the person's willingness or consent to participate.

Smith Commerce and your Orientation Week Leaders are committed to ensuring your introduction to Queen's is inclusive and memorable. We also recognize that not everyone will wish to participate. All of the activities during Orientation Week are optional. If you would rather not participate, or would rather watch some events, you may do so at any time.

I would also like to iterate that all Smith Commerce students are members of their faculty from the first day that they arrive on campus. It is important that you remain true to your personal values during Orientation Week and beyond, and that you remember you are representing Smith School of Business on campus and off campus. Ensure that you continue to conduct yourself with the same high standards and values that helped you to gain admission to this Program.

During Orientation Week, the members of the Commerce Program staff and I will conduct academic sessions and will be attending Orientation Week events. We encourage you to come and see us in the Commerce Office during Orientation Week (or at any time after the term begins) should you have any questions.

COMMERCE TIPS & TRICKS

RESEARCH POOL: Participating in the research pool can boost one of your course grades per semester. Check course outlines to see if they are eligible for the research pool. And visit the research pool portal for details and deadlines.

TEXTBOOKS: Wait until your professor discusses the syllabus in class before you buy your textbooks. Sometimes professors will suggest an online version. Reach out to upper year students to buy your books for cheaper – but be careful that you are getting the right edition!

MICROSOFT OFFICE: As a Queen's student, you are entitled to a copy of Microsoft Office. Download it online or head to tech support in the basement of Goodes for help downloading.

TUTORIALS: All tutorials in Commerce are optional, but they are highly recommended. TAs are knowledgeable and these sessions also often provide you with one-on-one help, if needed.

BRAINTRUST: A great student-run tutoring resource if you're ever struggling in quantitative specific classes. All tutors are upper year students - you can sign up to be a tutee at the beginning of every semester!



EVENTS AND CONFERENCES:

Attending conferences as well as Commerce events is an awesome way to meet upper years and make new friends. This is also a great way to get involved without over-committing yourself!

GETTING INVOLVED: Applying for first year representative positions in the Commerce Society is a great way to be involved. However, there are many other ways to get involved if you are not hired as a first year rep. For example, look at Queen's groups and get involved outside of Commerce.

QUEEN'S EMAIL: Make sure to check this regularly. This is where you receive important information. It also has a database of all Commerce students and professors.

PRINTING PLAN: Load your student card with Tricolour cash that can be used for printing at Goodes Hall and in Queen's Libraries.

LEARNING THE LINGO

COMSOC: The short form for Commerce Society. Make sure to check the ComSoc website often to stay up to date with everything going on in Commerce. (Visit the website: <https://comsoc.ca>)

ASSEMBLY: Assembly is the governing body of ComSoc. They oversee all the activities and operations of the society.

AMS: The AMS is the Alma Mater Society and is the oldest and largest student government society in Canada, and is for all Queen's faculties. The main office can be found in the JDUC.

THE STUDENT COMPUTING CENTRE: The Student Computing Centre is located in the basement of Goodes Hall and will fulfill all your printing needs. They play great music, and makes for a great study spot.

THE PORTAL: The Commerce portal will soon become your most checked website. This is where you will find all your class information, and your professors will upload class slides, grades, and other important information.

TECH SUPPORT: This is one of the best Commerce resources. Located in the basement of Goodes Hall, they will help you with any computer problems you may have and provide you with a loaner laptop. You can also rent cameras and tripods from them (for free!)

THE LOUNGE: Located adjacent to the atrium, you will find TVs and couches, It is a great place to meet up with your friends, or study between classes.

THE COMMONS: This is the area located directly beside Starbucks. It is a great spot to meet up with friends or do some readings between classes.

BREAKOUT ROOMS: Breakout rooms will soon become the place to study and meet in groups. You can book a breakout room a week in advance for up to two hours per day for group meetings and group study sessions.

THE ARC: The ARC, aka the 'Athletics and Recreations Center' is where you will find the gym. In addition, there are many food outlets where you can use your meal plan to grab a bite on campus.

COGRO: The Common Ground Coffee House arguably has the best sandwiches and bagels on campus. Unfortunately, it is not covered by your meal plan, but it is a great place to study. They also hire students for part-time jobs.

QP: Stop by the Queen's Pub in the JDUC for delicious, and inexpensive food. Also, be sure to keep an eye-out as they often offer awesome deals on food and drinks on the weekend! It is worth noting that after 8pm QP is strictly 19+. They also hire students for part-time jobs.

FALL SEMESTER:

COMM 103- BUSINESS

MANAGEMENT: This course is very general and covers different areas of business. This course will also be your first group experience - get ready for Capsim Class of '23.

COMM 153- MANAGING WORK &

TEAMS: Listen up Commies - this course will provide you with strategies for group work as well as dealing with all kinds of personalities. Key for surviving in this program, and in the business world.

COMM 111- FINANCIAL ACCOUNTING:

Prepare yourself for debits and credits galore. The tutorials for this course are very useful so make sure you go.

COMM 161- MATHEMATICAL ANALYSIS FOR MANAGEMENT

(CALCULUS): High School Mathletes will love this course. Go to class, do your practice problems, and keep up-to-date with the material.

ECON 110/111-112- PRINCIPLES

OF ECONOMICS: This is your only full year course, and your only course not in Goodes Hall! Stay on top of your work and use old exam banks for helpful review!



WINTER SEMESTER:

COMM 105- BUSINESS

COMMUNICATIONS: Learn how to write a proper resume, cover letter, and research report. This course provides loads of important tactical knowledge.

COMM 112- MANAGEMENT

ACCOUNTING: You're not done with accounting just yet! Make sure to keep up with your readings and practice problems.

COMM 162- MANAGERIAL

STATISTICS: Make sure you attend classes and tutorials. Reach out and ask for help if you need it. This course will familiarize you with Excel and be primarily online.

COMM 151- ORGANIZATIONAL

BEHAVIOUR: You definitely do not want to fall behind in readings for this class, or else you will have trouble catching up for the final.



RESOURCES & SUPPORT

COMMERCE SPECIFIC

Starting first year university is a difficult transition, and we are here to help and make your university experience the best possible. If you are having trouble adjusting, there are people to help you along the way.

THE COMMERCE OFFICE

The Commerce Office is located on the main floor of Goodes Hall (Room 130). They are there to provide any type of assistance including academic and non-academic support. The Academic Advisors are available in the Commerce Office to answer any questions you have.

THE CAREER ADVANCEMENT CENTRE

The Career Advancement Centre (CAC) is there to help you with everything job related and more. Located in Room 244 of Goodes Hall, they provide career coaching, mock interviews, as well as help with your resume.

PROFESSORS & FACULTY

If you are ever struggling with a course or need accommodation, do not hesitate to reach out to your professors. They want you to succeed and are more than happy to help.

PERSONAL COUNSELLING SERVICES

The Commerce program provides a full-time personal counsellor. This is completely confidential and free of charge. Appointments can be made through the Commerce portal or in the Commerce Office. You can also receive counselling support through the counselling office located in Mitchell Hall

CAMPUS WIDE

STUDENT WELLNESS SERVICES
